 - o Aimed at operational readiness near the strategic 'Chicken's Neck' (Siliguri corridor, 22 km wide land link).
 - o Army Chief: General Upendra Dwivedi | Vice Chief: Lt. Gen. NS Raja Subramani
- "Operation Sindoor":
 - o Targeted strikes in Pakistan & POJK, response to the 22 April 2025 Pahalgam terrorist attack (26 civilians killed).
 - o **Indigenous "Akashteer" Air Defence System** by BEL played a key role (inducted 2024, contract: ₹1,982 crore).
- Operation Abhyas (Civil Defence Drill):
 - o Held after 53 years (last in 1971), conducted on 7 May 2025.

 - o **Top Importers:** Ukraine (8.8%), India (8.3%), Qatar (6.8%), Saudi Arabia (6.8%), Pakistan (4.6%)
 - o **India's arms supply:** 36% from Russia (biggest customer for Russia & France)
 - o **Exporters:** US (43%), France (9.6%), Russia (7.8%), China (5.9%), Germany (5.6%)
- Russia's "Zircon" Hypersonic Missile:
 - o Mach 9 (~10,000 kph), 1,500 km, test-fired from Admiral Gorshkov.
- Iran "Ete mad" Missile:
 - o Range: 1,700 km.
- US "Golden Dome" Missile Defence System:
 - o Budget: \$175 bn, operational by Jan 2029.
