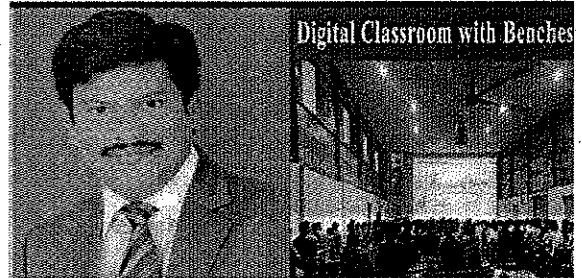

RBI Monetary Policy & Financial Sector Updates

Key Policy Rates and Banking Measures

- Repo rate cut by 50 bps to 5.5%
- Reverse Repo Rate: 3.35%
- SDF (Standing Deposit Facility): 5.25%
- Bank Rate & MSF (Marginal Standing Facility): 5.75%
- CRR (Cash Reserve Ratio) reduced by 100 bps to 3% (₹2.5 lakh crore liquidity released)
- SLR (Statutory Liquidity Ratio): 18%
- Policy stance: Shifted from 'accommodative' to 'neutral'
- Next Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) meeting: August 4-6, 2025
- RBI will stop daily VRR (Variable Rate Repo) auctions from June 12, 2025 as liquidity surplus in banks has improved

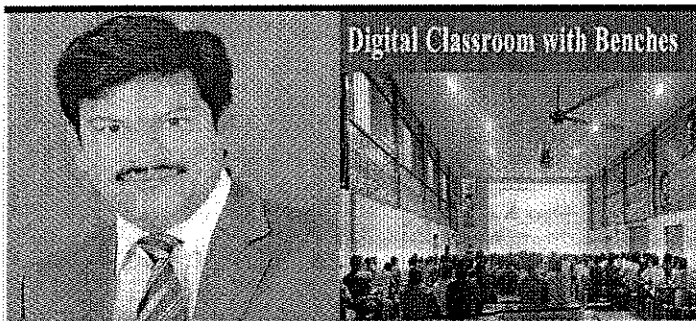

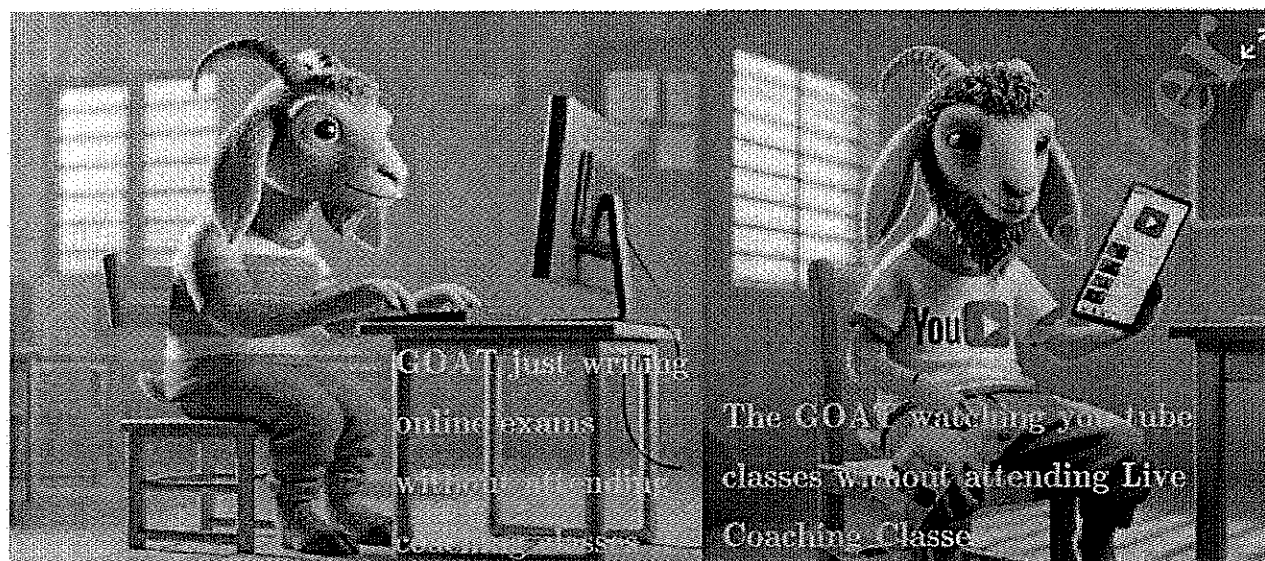
