## 1. G V Satish (NBCC Director) Sir's Top Picks

1. Simplification of EPF Partial Withdrawals & Digital Transformation under EPFO 3.0 Framework: The Central Board of Trustees (Employees' Provident Fund – CBT, EPF) held its 238<sup>th</sup> meeting in New Delhi, chaired by Dr Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister for Labour & Employment and Youth Affairs & Sports.  
Key Developments
  - Thirteen complex withdrawal provisions merged into three broad types –  
(i) Essential Needs (illness, education, marriage) (ii) Housing Needs (iii) Special Circumstances.
  - Members can now withdraw up to 100 % of the eligible Provident-Fund balance (employee + employer share).
  - Education withdrawals → 10 times, Marriage → 5 times (previously only 3 combined withdrawals allowed).
  - Minimum service requirement reduced to 12 months for all partial withdrawals.
  - At least 25 % of member's contribution must stay as minimum balance to earn 8.25 % p.a. interest and compounding benefits.
  - 100 % automatic settlement for partial-withdrawal claims introduced.
  - Premature final settlement period changed from 2 → 12 months; final pension withdrawal 2 → 36 months.
  - 'Vishwas Scheme' launched to settle penal-damage litigation for delayed PF remittances – Rs 2,406 crore pending across 6,000 + cases and 21,000 potential disputes.
2. India secured its seat for the 7<sup>th</sup> time in the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) for the term 2026–2028. The election was held by the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) in Geneva  
UNHRC HQ – Geneva, Switzerland | President: Jürg Lauber | Established: 2006
3. The Government-backed Bharat 6G Alliance hosted the International Bharat 6G Symposium 2025 during the India Mobile Congress (IMC 2025) in New Delhi. Theme of IMC 2025: 'Innovate to Transform.
4. StockGro, a Bengaluru-based FinTech platform, launched "Stoxo", India's first AI-powered stock-market research desk.

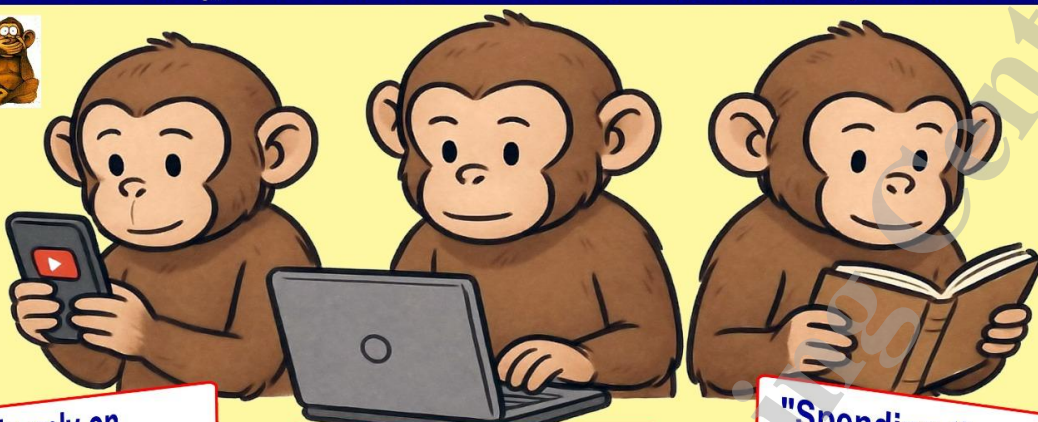
