#### **RBI** Transfers and Forex Operations

- RBI transferred ₹2,68,590.07 crore as surplus to the Central Government for 2024-25.
- RBI sold \$398.71 billion of foreign currency in 2024–25 (gross basis), higher than \$153.03 bn in FY24 and \$212.57 bn in FY23.

- Union Cabinet approved setting up the 8th Pay Commission to revise salaries of central government employees and allowances for pensioners.
