

Key State Schemes and Initiatives

I. Financial Assistance and Welfare Programs

- **Bihar: Mukhyamantri Mahila Rojgar Yojana**
 - Launched September 26, 2025, Ladli Behna Scheme**
 - The monthly financial aid was increased from ₹1,250 to ₹1,500 per month, effective October 2025, aiming for women empowerment.
- **Andhra Pradesh: Talliki Vandanam Scheme**
 - Provides ₹15,000 per year per school-going child via DBT to the mother's account, with **no limit on the number of eligible children** per household.
- **Andhra Pradesh: AP Municipal Workers Insurance**
 - Offers ₹1 crore insurance for regular municipal workers and ₹20 lakh for outsourced municipal workers, alongside up to ₹8 lakh for their children's education.
- **Gujarat: Namo Lakshmi Yojana**
 - Supports girl students in Classes 9–12 by providing ₹50,000 over four years. Over 10.49 lakh girl students have benefited from the disbursement.
- **Jharkhand: Maiyyaan Sampan Yojana**
 - The enhanced scheme (January 2025) provides ₹5,000 assistance for two months to 56.61 lakh women beneficiaries.
- **Chhattisgarh: Deendayal Upadhyay Bhoomiheen Krishi Majdoor Kalyana Yojana**
 - Provides ₹10,000 annually to landless agricultural labourers, Baigas, Gunias, and other landless families.
- **Himachal Pradesh: Indira Gandhi Sukh Shiksha Yojana**
 - Gives ₹1,000 per month financial aid to 23,000 vulnerable students (orphans, children of widows/divorced/disabled parents).
- **Delhi: Delhi Collateral-Free Loan Scheme**
 - Provides collateral-free credit up to ₹10 crore for small businesses and women entrepreneurs, with guarantees partially covered by the Delhi Government.
- **Goa: Raj Bhavan Annadhan Scheme**
 - Provides ₹25,000 per person in financial assistance to needy patients suffering from serious diseases like cancer or dialysis, funded from the Governor's discretionary fund.

II. Health, Safety, and Quality of Life

- **Kerala: Extreme Poverty-Free Status & Sushakthi Initiative**
 - Kerala declared itself **India's first extreme-poverty-free state** on November 1, 2025.
 - The **Sushakthi** initiative was launched to empower Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) and their families by forming Self-Help Groups (SHGs) where a minimum of **40% of members must be PwDs**.
- **Tamil Nadu: Women's Wellness on Wheels (WWW) Mobile Cancer Screening Initiative**
 - This is **India's first mobile cancer screening initiative**, utilizing 38 mobile units with an outlay of ₹41 crore.
 - The state will also provide **free Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination** to girls aged 14 and below.
- **Punjab: Mukhyamantri Sehat Yojana**
 - Offers free, cashless medical treatment up to ₹10 lakh per family per year.
- **Madhya Pradesh: Rah-veer Scheme**
 - The incentive for **Good Samaritans** who help road accident victims was significantly increased from ₹5,000 to ₹25,000.
- **Maharashtra: Disha Abhiyan**

- Maharashtra became the **first state in India** to implement this campaign aimed at providing **equal education to students with intellectual disabilities**.
- **Goa: Prayas**
 - Launched as **India's first integrated Neuro-Rehabilitation Centre** at AIIA, combining Ayurveda, yoga, and modern medicine.
- **Delhi: Pink Saheli Smart Card**
 - Launched for **free bus travel** for women and transgender commuters (aged 12 years and above).

III. Education, Skill Development, and Youth

- **Gujarat: Namo Saraswati Vigyan Sadhana Yojana**
 - Provides **₹25,000 over two years** for students pursuing science streams who achieve at least 50% in Class 10.
- **Tripura: Skill Uday Tongai Scheme**
 - Trains 8,000 students in crucial skills like **English Communication, Cyber Security, and Drone Technology**.
- **Uttar Pradesh: Atal Bihari Vajpayee Shivning Scholarship Scheme**
 - Enables meritorious students to pursue **higher education in the United Kingdom**.
- **Assam: CM Flight Scheme (Foreign Language Initiative)**
 - Aims to teach **foreign languages** (like Japanese in Phase 1) and essential workplace skills to connect youth with global opportunities.
- **Bihar: CM-PRATIGYA**
 - Provides monthly stipends to youth for internships, with **Graduates/PG interns receiving ₹6,000**.
- **Kerala: Jyoti Scheme**
 - Launched in May 2025 to **educate migrant children**.
- **Uttarakhand: Madrassa Board Dissolution**
 - The state became the first to **dissolve its Madrassa Board** and introduce a **Minority Education Act**.

IV. Environment, Agriculture, and Infrastructure

- **Maharashtra: Krishi Samruddhi Scheme**
 - Launched with a massive **₹25,000 crore budget** over 5 years to promote climate-resilient, sustainable agriculture.
- **Telangana: Indira Soura Giri Jala Vikasam**
 - Provides **solar-powered borewell irrigation** for tribal farmers with a **100% subsidy** and a total outlay of **₹12,600 crore**.
- **Himachal Pradesh: Cow Dung Purchasing Scheme**
 - Supports farmers by purchasing organic manure/vermicompost for **Rs 300 per quintal** via direct bank transfer.
- **Himachal Pradesh: Rajiv Gandhi Start-up Swarojgar Yojana (E-taxi Scheme)**
 - Promotes self-employment through the adoption of electric vehicles, offering a **50% subsidy** on e-taxi purchases.
- **Himachal Pradesh: Rajiv Gandhi Van Samvardhan Yojana & Green Adoption Scheme**
 - Launched to **enhance green cover** and mandate community/corporate participation in afforestation.
- **Punjab: Amended Bharat Net Scheme**
 - Punjab became the **first state in India** to implement this scheme throughout the state to enhance internet connectivity.

V. Unique Administrative and Reform Measures

- **Sikkim: Sabbatical Leave Scheme**
 - Sikkim is the **first state in India** to introduce a formal sabbatical scheme, allowing government employees (with ≥ 5 years service) to take 365 to 1,080 days of leave while receiving **50% of their basic pay**.
- **Karnataka: Paid Menstrual Leave**
 - Became the **first Indian state** to approve **one day of paid menstrual leave per month** for all women employees across government and private sectors.
- **Maharashtra: Starlink Partnership**
 - Maharashtra became the **first Indian state** to sign a Letter of Intent (LoI) with **Elon Musk's Starlink** for satellite internet services.
- **Chhattisgarh: Child Marriage-Free District**
 - **Balod** became India's **first district** officially recognized as "Child Marriage-Free".
- **Goa: Mhaje Ghar Yojana**
 - Grants **ownership rights** to citizens residing in houses with long-standing legal or land disputes.
- **Haryana: QR Kiosk for Challans**
 - **Gurugram** became the first Indian city to launch **QR code-based kiosks** for instant digital payment of traffic challans.
